The Palazzi IGT 2015 vintage of the Tenuta di Trinoro was voted the best wine at the Merano WineFestival. Thus, this red wine has first place amongst the 25 Platinum wines selected by The Wine Hunter Helmuth Köcher.

Meran, 12th November 2017 – On the evening of November 11th, in the auditorium of the Ariston Cinema, the best wine of the Merano WineFestival was announced. The winner is the Tuscan red wine Palazzi IGT vintage 2015, by Vini Franchetti Tenuta di Trinoro. This wine emerged as the clear winner out of the selection of the 25 Platinum winners of a WineHunter Award - the online wine guide available on the award.winehunter.it website. The guide provides information on the wines selected by The Wine Hunter, the "wine hunter" Helmuth Köcher, and that have been awarded the designation ROT (ROSSO), GOLD (ORO) and Platinum (PLATINUM).

The coveted prize, created in collaboration with the Donne del Vino (Women of Wine) Association, was awarded by the Stehwein Commission from Meran. The Commission has chosen the "Best of the Best" from amongst the 25 Platinum Winners announced at the Hotel Terme Meran on November 11th (complete list is attached). Andrea Franchetti accepted the award from Helmuth Köcher as part of the Merano WineFestival focus on film at the end of the documentary screening. The film "NOMA" was presented about the eponymous restaurant in Copenhagen, which for four years has been awarded the prize for "Best Restaurant in the World," and is a pioneer in the field of "natural wines" and fermented foods, both of which have already been included in their 2010 wine list and menu.
