Surgiva, one of the lightest Italian mineral waters, the soul of Trentino at its most authentic, after its long journey underground springs from a source at high altitude in Adamello Brenta Nature Park, in an unspoilt environment in the North-East of Italy.

Its freshness and transparency mingle with the light of the mountain that preserve its extraordinary purity.

With a fixed residue of just 41 mg/l it is a slightly mineralized water and it is recommended for low-sodium diets. It is only bottled in clear glass bottles, ideal for enhancing its organoleptic characteristics, and it is immediately recognizable and distinctive for the captivating design of the bottle and label. It can be found exclusively in the very best restaurant, hotels and gastronomic boutiques.

In its three versions: Naturale (still), Frizzante (sparkling) and Mossa (slightly sparkling), Surgiva has conquered a public of specialized consumers and, in a short time, has become synonymous with a refined and exclusive mineral water. Its neutral taste allows it not to alter the taste of the foods and wines it accompanies. And it is therefore no coincidence that the Italian Association of Sommeliers has chosen it as its official water.

On the wave of this extraordinary success, the Trentino water has consolidated its position on the national market and yielded excellent results beyond the Italian borders, from Japan to Germany, from Great Britain to South Africa and in many other countries.

Surgiva, the only water that can bear the trademark of the Adamello Brenta Nature Park, chooses nature and for years it has been involved in various projects of the Park to protect the priceless natural heritage of these mountains.

Surgiva was founded in 1975 and taken over in 1988 by the Lunelli family, for three generations at the head of Ferrari Trento Winery.

Thanks to its consistent adherence to the values such as research for excellence and the close link with its territory, Surgiva perfectly completes the range of products produced by Gruppo Lunelli, which encompasses Ferrari Trentodoc sparkling wine, Segnana grappa, Tenute Lunelli wines from Trentino, Tuscany and Umbria and BISOL1542 Prosecco Superiore.
